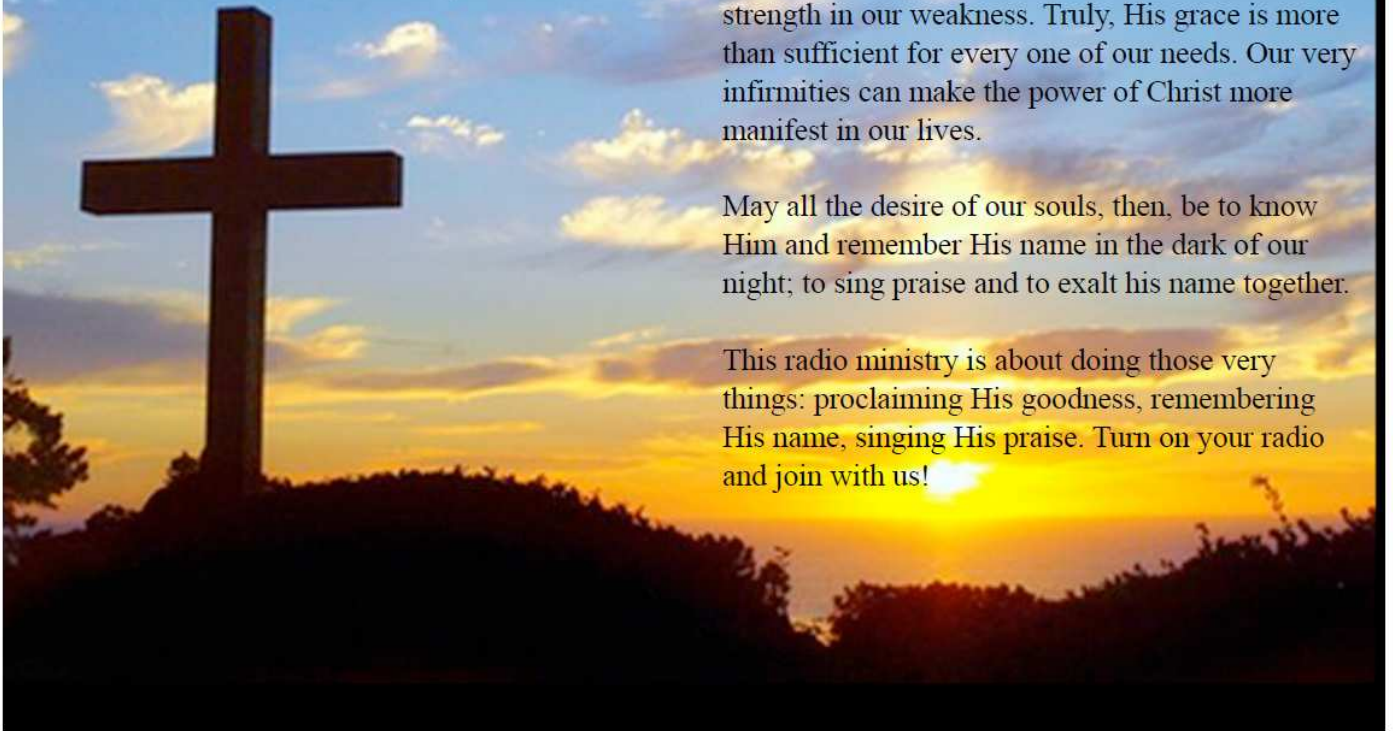

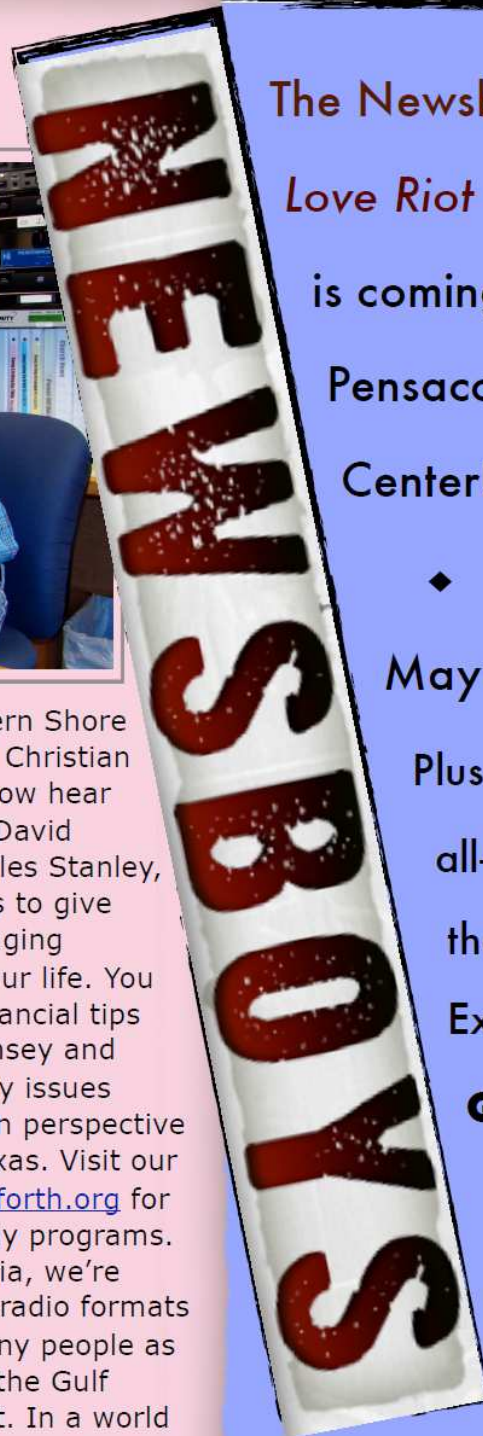

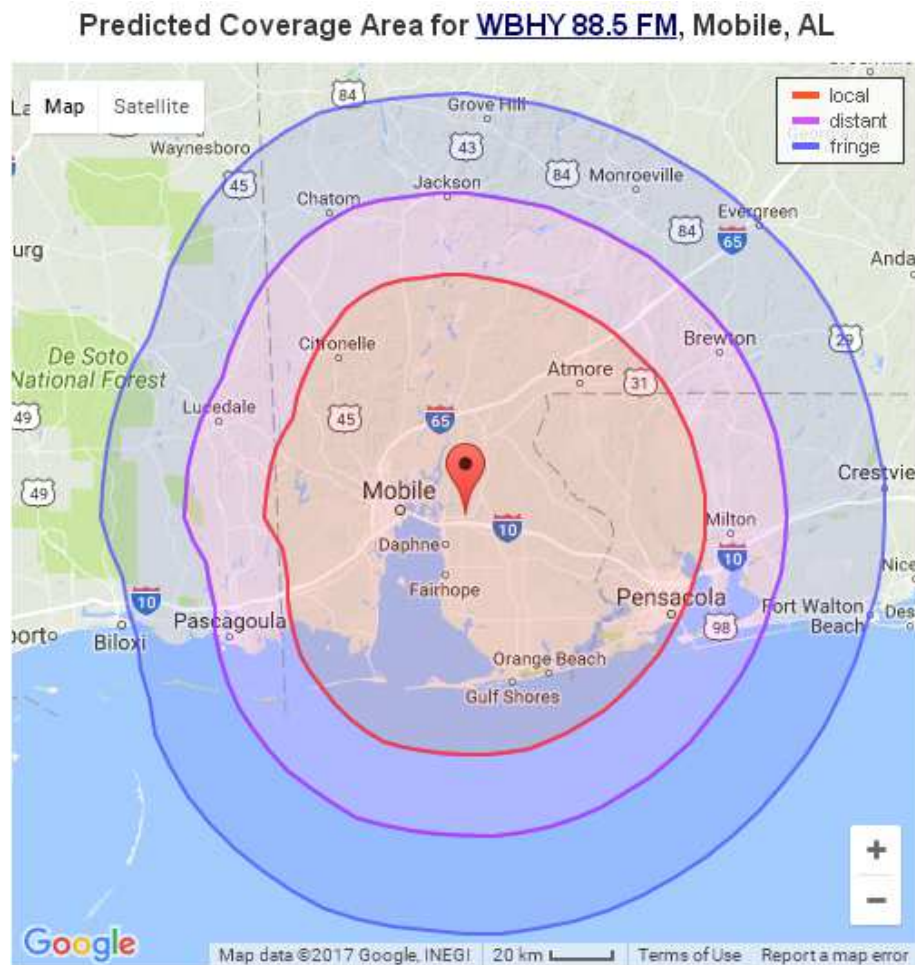
Power 88 Power Increase

God has blessed Power 88 to serve the people in the Mobile area for 25 years. Now He has opened a new door for Power 88 to reach even more people with the gospel.

On March 28th the FCC approved Goforth Media application to increase tower height and power from 33,000 watts to 100,000 watts. This will increase the strength of our signal over our current coverage area and add much additional coverage to the Pensacola and Milton, Florida area.
